Melbourne at students' feet

Undera Primary School grade 5/6 students and teachers were in Melbourne last week with the help of Urban Camp's Country Victoria Program.

In response to their vision to improve quality of life, Urban Camp assists eligible schools from economically challenged areas with their Country Relief Project, which began in 2001.

But nothing they had ever experienced prepared students for the awe-inspiring views from the highest viewing plat-

form in the Southern Hemisphere at Melbourne's iconic Eureka Tower.

Students were able to touch and discover the award-winning 6m multi-user 'Serenity' table which explores the stories and history of Melbourne. Then in less than 40 seconds students arrived at the 88th floor to be amazed by the breathtaking views of the city.

Students were challenged to identify the sounds of Melbourne as they walked around

utilising the many view finders and scrolling LED floor and wall displays.

On the open air terrace students witnessed up close the drama as the 'Edge' slides out from the building and becomes transparent almost 300 m above the ground.
